

Communication with Schools Checklist Language:

The probable cause findings on abuse/neglect matters would read as follows:

The Department of Health and Human Services, or their designee, shall communicate with a school age child's home district to assure that all educational needs are being addressed and report the findings of such to counsel of record and to the court at the scheduled protective custody/detention hearing set herein by way of a checklist provided by the court. The information shall include where the child is enrolled, if the child is receiving any special education services or is enrolled in any gifted programs, school attendance, identifying what classes the minor is either failing or close to failing, those classes where the minor is performing at an above average level, and if a parent/guardian attended the last parent teacher conference.

The clause for a detention hearing involving a youngster who is either detained in our facility or placed at home on electronic monitoring would read as follows:

The Juvenile Probation Office shall communicate with the minor's school district to assure that all educational needs are being addressed and report the findings of such to counsel of record within one week of the order herein by way of a checklist provided by the court. The information shall include the where the child is enrolled, if the child is receiving any special education services or is enrolled in any gifted programs, school attendance, identifying what classes the minor is either failing or close to failing, those classes where the minor is performing at an above average level and if a parent/guardian attended the last parent teacher conference.
